
THE ROOF

We are thrilled that work has now begun to repair the roof of The Dream Factory. The building wouldn't have been able to survive another winter, so this is really marvellous.

We are lucky that the work can take place without us having to close the building, however there will still be an impact on everyone, while the work is taking place. The rear car park is for builders' traffic and Playbox staff only. Please keep access to the staff road clear, as this is also for emergency vehicles.

The front car park will get full very quickly, so we strongly advise you to park away from The Dream Factory, then use the pedestrian gate to walk in. There is roadside parking on Shelley Avenue and Tapping Way. Please be considerate of neighbours and drive very carefully when entering and leaving the site.

It might also be very noisy in The Dream Factory while the work is happening! We know you will be understanding during this essential period of repairs.
