Our directors (Ed Buckley, Miriam Clements, Amèlie Friess and Corin Alford) began production in early September. We love employing Playbox young people, as they bridge the transition from school to 'next steps', and this year Miriam Clements takes on a new position with Playbox, as well as continuing to train and perform with us, alongside her work with Millennial Wizard. Here, Miriam shares some thoughts from her first few weeks...



Hello, I'm Miriam and I'm taking a gap year this year, spending most of it at my favourite place: Playbox! I've been a member of Playbox since 2021 and since then I have been in MARINER as the wife of the doomed Ancient Mariner, ORESTEIA as the fortune-telling Cassandra, and most recently THE MYSTERIES as Jesus. THE MYSTERIES, which tells the story of the Bible through medieval language but modern dress, was one of my favourite experiences and made me even more motivated to pursue a career in theatre because I loved it so much!

This year, I'm working at Playbox as an Admin Assistant, Workshop Assistant and Duty Manager. I'm also in CHIMES AT MIDNIGHT - an adaptation of Shakespeare's Henry IV Parts 1 and 2 - playing Lady Percy, CINDERELLA playing Princess Madeline, and Millennial Wizard's THE DUCHESS OF MALFI playing the Duchess of Malfi. Despite my constant state of busyness, I have absolutely loved joining the Playbox team as a staff member, getting up to all sorts during my shifts while I rehearse for the upcoming shows.

As a Duty Manager I love being a friendly face welcoming anyone and everyone through the doors of The Dream Factory and being able to answer (almost) all of their questions while keeping our front-of-house looking spotless. Watching Playbox members and their families and friends enjoying the delicious treats of Cafe Whirl, making the most of our library corner or just generally relaxing in the front-of-house makes me proud to work for the best youth theatre ever.

My favourite part of being a Workshop Assistant - both with Toby on his Thursday sessions and with Stacey on her Early Stagers sessions - is knowing that I will get to see the children who attend every week really grow in confidence and enthusiasm as time goes on. I love being part of the children's Playbox journeys as they realise their potential as creators, makers and storytellers because I can see them as the creative, bold and brilliant leaders of the future.

My work as an Admin Assistant is easily the most varied and exciting job I've ever done because I just get up to ALL sorts. From designing invitations to making important phone calls and from keeping the website up-to-date to putting together this very newsletter, every day is a new adventure!

WORK EXPERIENCE – ETHAN'S REPORT



This week, Playbox long-timer Ethan Phillips has been working with us (and is responsible for lots of the new merchandise range!). Here, Ethan shares a few words about being on the 'other side' of Playbox Theatre.

Hello, I'm Ethan! Today I want to talk a bit about what it has been like the past few days doing work experience at Playbox.

I have been going to Stratford playbox since I was about three years old, so now being sixteen years old and doing work experience at The Dream Factory almost seems surreal!

From being in shows, attending my weekly sessions and assisting Apple Club, the last thing I saw myself doing was being sat at the box office designing Playbox's winter merchandise (buy on the website now!).
